Status: Seasonal, Full-time, Hourly

Pay Range: \$15.96-\$17.00 Hourly (depending on experience) Location: Campus by the Sea (Santa Catalina Island, CA)

To advance the purpose of Campus by the Sea, this position will support the ongoing ministry of the camp with a strong work ethic, servant's heart, a desire to grow spiritually and a willingness to care for guests and other staff in our kitchen, dining room, dish area and laundry.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Support the preparation & serving of foods in accordance with food safety, nutritional & dietary needs.
- Assist in the delivery, storage & tracking of food products.
- Maintain the cleanliness of kitchen areas & equipment.
- Lead our guests in cleaning and re-setting our dining room & dish area (a.k.a., "OTS" = Opportunity to serve).

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Annually affirm the Campus by the Sea Statement of Faith, Mission and Purpose.
- A willingness to be trained in the areas of: food handling, serving, guest host, dish steward, laundry facilities.
- Ability to exemplify the love of Christ through humble, excellent and genuine guest service.
- A willingness to speak to guests and staff in a public setting.
- Must possess excellent personal hygiene and manners.
- High School graduate and at least 17 years of age
- Willingness to work at least 40 hours per week on a varied schedule including evenings, weekends and split shifts.
- Must be able to work in a multigenerational and multicultural environment and demonstrate willingness to contribute to
- positive community development.
- Ability to stand for long periods and to lift or carry items 40 lbs. or less.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Professional certifications in Food Handing (ServSafe), First Aid, CPR & AED
- InterVarsity background or equivalent ministry experience and culture
- College graduate, trade-school certificate or post-secondary coursework
- Preferably at least 18 years of age
- Professional camping and/or ministry experience.
